Subject: **Project Update** – Emergency Pavement Repairs on the 4600 to 4900 Blocks of Pennsylvania Ave., Project E-1009A

Dear Resident:

Crescenta Valley Water District (CVWD) would like to update property owners, residents and the general public regarding progress of the pavement restoration on Pennsylvania Ave between El Caminito St. and Pontiac St.

On August 4, 2019, a water main break occurred on the existing 8-inch water main near the intersection of El Caminito St. and Pennsylvania Ave. which caused damage to the roadway.

Crescenta Valley Water District is contracting with Paveco Construction, Inc. (Paveco) to repair the AC pavement damaged by the recent water main break. Paveco will begin construction on August 23, 2019 between El Caminito St. and Alabama St. and then proceed south towards Pontiac St. The temporary pavement repairs should be completed by September 6, 2019 to restore traffic and parking access. A permanent pavement replacement will occur in November 2019.

Paveco will be working with the City of Glendale and County of Los Angeles inspectors on the extent of the damage and there may be areas where the repairs will be more extensive than anticipated.

The first phase of the work will be on Pennsylvania Ave between El Caminito St. and Alabama St. After phase 1 is complete, thru-traffic on Pennsylvania Ave will be restored. The second phase will be between Alabama St. and Pontiac St. The bulk of this work will be on the southbound lane of Pennsylvania Ave. Thru-traffic on Pennsylvania shall be maintained while the second phase of work is proceeding.

Paveco will be placing temporary no parking signs, traffic cones, detour signage and arrow boards along Pennsylvania Ave. between El Caminito St. and Pontiac St. This will allow the contractor's crew to work in a safe and expeditious manner to complete the project. Temporary "No Parking" signs will be posted a minimum of two (2) days before construction showing the time limit (i.e. 8 am to 4 pm) for parking restrictions. Residents will be allowed to park in these areas during off hours, when the area is safe.

This project will require the use of large trucks to transport materials to and from the site. CVWD asks that you observe all traffic control signs and instructions from field personnel to ensure a safe working and driving environment. Driveways within the construction zone may be temporarily restricted due to the construction. CVWD's on-site inspector and the contractor will assist you with access into and out of your driveway, if this occurs.

As in most construction projects, the work will create a certain amount of unavoidable public inconvenience. Your cooperation in making this project successful will be greatly appreciated.
